Our Christmas Dinner event this year will be held at the Ilsington Country Hotel and Spa, situated on the edge of Dartmoor, not far from Newton Abbot. Some of you already know Ilsington offering comfort and good food with use of the Spa facilities. We will have exclusive use of the Hound Tor Suite for our dinner

We have guaranteed 10 rooms for the night and currently further rooms are available. For those wishing to stay the Saturday night making a weekend break, (The Dinner will be on the Friday night and it will be possible to make it into a two-night stay if you wish)

It is appreciated Christmas seems a long way ahead, but as always, bearing in mind the time of year, those booking early are likely to fulfil their requirements. Normally

rooms for the Saturday night are more expensive than weekdays, however the Friday night rate will apply to the Saturday for those wishing to have a weekend break. The following rates are for two people sharing a double or twin room and includes breakfast, 3 course dinner, service and VAT. Full use of the Spa facilities is also included. Numbers in brackets (below) are the numbers of each room type available.
